All books except where indicated are in the Library of St Andrews University; and the classmark is given. The inscriptions are transcribed as they appear on the books, with the abbreviations expanded and placed within square brackets.

Guild is known to have owned a copy of this edition of the works of St Ambrose. Durkan and Ross identify part 1 of the set, which also has the ownership inscription of William Hay of Turriff, in the library of Professor Greenslade, Durham.² Professor Greenslade, later Regius Professor of Divinity, Christ Church, Oxford, died in 1977. The whereabouts of his library has not been established. St Andrews University Library owns an incomplete copy of parts 2 and 3 also with William Hay's inscription and which was therefore probably part of the same set. The St Andrews set has no indication of Guild's ownership (TypSwB.A92AA).

The complete set of this edition of St Bonaventure's works was owned by Alexander Young and John Annand, canons of the Augustinian priory of St Andrews and masters at St Leonard's College. It seems that in the 1550s the set was split and the volume containing parts 3 and 4 was taken to Aberdeen by Alexander Arbuthnot, who was a student at St Mary's College in 1552. This volume went into the library of William Guild and eventually found its way to Glasgow University Library. The volume containing parts 1 and 2 remained in St Andrews and was never owned by Guild (TypFL.B15SP (pts 1-2)).
