### GP Johnston Prize

### Scottish Book History and Bibliography

Named after the Edinburgh bookseller and bibliophile George P. Johnston, founder of the EBS and its secretary from 1890-1932, the essay prize is **open to current graduate/postgraduate students and early-career researchers who received their final degree not more than eight years before entering.**

Essays submitted for the annual competition can cover any period of book history or topic of bibliographic interest. All other things being equal, preference will be given to essays on subjects with a connection to Scotland, or based on material held in Scotland, and/or written by students or scholars working in Scotland.

The winner will receive **£200**, and submitted essays will be considered for publication in the Journal of the Edinburgh Bibliographical Society.

Submissions should not exceed 8,000 words and should not have been published previously. The deadline for submissions is **March 31**.
